Bassetlaw is fortunate that it has many active groups to support and improve lifestyle. Access to information about how and where services are provided is very important.


As a result, Bassetlaw Action Centre produced this Directory to inform Older People about the services available.

AURORA WELLBEING CENTRE – WORKSOP

The Aurora Wellbeing Centre in Worksop is a unique, community-based service supporting people affected by cancer and long-term health conditions across Bassetlaw. We empower individuals to be active participants in their own wellbeing, working alongside them to support both physical and emotional health.

Our Bassetlaw services are delivered from the historic Old Library and Museum building in Worksop. The Centre is open to the public Monday to Friday from 9am to 4pm, with therapy appointments running until 5pm. Valerie's Tearoom, located within the Centre, is open from 9am to 3pm.

Therapy Suite

Our Therapy Suite provides specialist cancer support alongside a wide range of therapeutic services. These include beauty and holistic therapies, one-to-one and group counselling, wellbeing workshops, counselling for young people affected by cancer, and regular peer support groups.

Heritage Hub

Through our Heritage Hub, we use local history and heritage to enhance wellbeing. Activities include art therapy groups, History Maker family sessions, and heritage-inspired social groups. Visitors are welcome daily to explore Worksop's history through hands-on objects and shared stories.

The Curve Gym

The Curve Gym offers a programme of specialist exercise sessions for people affected by cancer, using a range of fitness equipment. Alongside these, we run other exercise sessions open to the

general public, including Tai Chi, Pilates, and Yoga, to support movement, strength, and relaxation for everyone.

Community Space

Our Community Space includes Valerie's Tearoom, a volunteer-led charity shop, and a range of meeting and community rooms. Valerie's Tearoom sits within the Centre, overlooking the park, and serves home-cooked food in a welcoming setting. Community rooms host support groups including bereavement support, prostate cancer groups, partners' groups, and drop-in sessions for people living with long-term health conditions. Rooms are also available to hire for meetings, workshops, and training.

Aurora Wellbeing is open to everyone. We offer a varied programme of sociable, supportive, educational, and relaxed activities, events, and projects designed to improve wellbeing and reduce isolation across our community.

The Handy Person Adaptation Service provides help and support to keep people safe and secure in their home with free or low-cost but high quality essential adaptations and small practical jobs. This service is available to people living in Nottinghamshire (except the City of Nottingham) who are either:

- aged 60 or over
- disabled.
- Adaptations
- Adaptations are jobs such as fitting stair rails and grab rails which help you move around your home and stay steady on your feet.

These are supplied and fitted in a single job and are free of charge.

- Handy person jobs

- Handy person jobs are small jobs such as fixing curtain rails, putting up shelves or fixing loose carpets or trip hazards.

The cost of a handy person job is £15 which should be given to the trader. You will also need to supply all the materials for the job. But if you have difficulty getting what's needed, you may be able to give the money to the trader so they can buy the materials for you. These prices are subject to change, so please check when requesting a job to confirm the price.

- How long does it take to get the work done?
- Jobs inside the house are usually completed within 5 working days.

If you have been discharged from hospital the job will be completed within 2 working days. The work is carried out by professional traders from our approved trader register regulated by Trading Standards.

FREE CONCESSIONARY TRAVEL SCHEME

Who is eligible?

The scheme no longer provides a free pass automatically at the age of 60. Instead, the qualifying age is now linked to the state pension age. To see when you will qualify for a free pass on age grounds, have a look on www.gov.uk/calculate-state-pension

You are an eligible disabled person if you:

- are blind or partially sighted
- are profoundly or severely deaf
- are without speech
- have a disability, or have suffered an injury, which has a substantial and long-term adverse effect on your ability to walk
- do not have arms or have long term loss of the use of both arms
- have a learning disability - a state of arrested or incomplete development of mind which includes significant impairment of intelligence and social functioning, or
- would have an application to drive a motor vehicle refused due to your disability.

When can you use your pass?

The National Concessionary Pass allows you to enjoy free off-peak travel on local buses anywhere in England. The national free entitlement operates between 9:30am and 11:00pm Monday to Friday and all day at weekends and on public holidays.

How do you apply for your travel pass and how much does it cost?

The concessionary travel passes are initially free of charge, however if you lose your pass a fee may be charged for the replacement.

WHAT IS ABUSE OR MISTREATMENT?

Abuse or mistreatment can be many things.

Physical including hitting, slapping, punching, kicking or the misuse of medication on someone. Sexual including rape or sexual assault acts which the person has not consented to. It may be non-contact such as teasing or being photographed.

Psychological including threats, humiliating someone, controlling or intimidating.

Financial including stealing or tricking the person out of money or material possessions like their house or jewellery.

Discriminatory including racist, sexist, that is based on a person's disability and other forms of harassment.

Neglect is also a form of abuse - leaving someone without food or heating, refusing to take care of personal needs and failing to provide access to appropriate health and social care may all be forms of neglect.

BASSETLAW TELEPHONE BEFRIENDING

Face to Face Befriending

Our befriending scheme can receive referrals from anyone who is suffering from extreme loneliness. Befriending is a means to reduce isolation and increase independence.

Our clients are placed with a befriender who will visit them for one hour a week in their own home or telephone them to chat and encouraging them to make positive choices to help them to help themselves.

When the clients are referred to us, we match them with a volunteer, who may have similar interests and hobbies and lives in the same area. This service is free of charge, but there may be travel costs incurred for the volunteer mileage if they are visiting in the home.

Telephone Befriending

Our telephone befriending is a free service which offers weekly calls made to our clients by volunteers.

As with home visits, we ensure to match our clients with a volunteer who may have similar interests or hobbies, and the volunteer will encourage clients over the duration of the call to make positive choices.

For those clients who are unable to have home visits or use the telephone we may be able to offer befriending letters.

Peer to Peer Befriending

Peer to peer befriending is a great way for clients to support each other through weekly telephone calls. Befriending not only benefits the person who receives the call but also the person who provides the call. People often volunteer for Befriending as a way to reduce their own isolation and loneliness whilst helping another person.

As such we now offer Peer to Peer Befriending Support. This is where 2 clients waiting for a volunteer will contact each other via telephone and Befriend each other. This enables both clients to give and receive support, build friendships and help each other overcome their feelings of loneliness and isolation.

Our befriending scheme is available for people who are identified as socially isolated. We hope to reduce isolation and increase independence for our clients by providing befrienders who will encourage clients to make positive choices and help them to help themselves. The befriending service is currently telephone based and our volunteers offer their support to clients through regular phone calls.

Bassetlaw Community Car Scheme

If you enjoy driving and meeting people and are looking to help the local community, you are the ideal person to be a volunteer driver. Any amount of time that you are able to give to the scheme is welcomed, even an hour or two each week. We are all part of a friendly team and drivers help and support each other in addition to receiving support and training from the staff at The Bassetlaw Action Centre. We do not put any pressure on our drivers and are grateful for any amount of time that they are able to give to the Car Scheme. Many clients have managed to remain independent because of the valuable help they have received from our volunteer drivers. We pay 45p per mile for every mile that you drive on behalf of the scheme.

Bassetlaw Community Car Scheme Plus

We are also looking for drivers for our Community Car Scheme Plus vehicle. This vehicle has been fully adapted for wheelchair users and offers a door to door service for people of all ages. The vehicle is also able to carry up to 4 passengers. We provide all training for this vehicle which will help individuals to travel in safety and comfort to make those important appointments, get to work or simply socialise with friends for an affordable fare.

Bassetlaw Community Minibus

We are always looking to add to our bank of volunteer drivers for the minibus at The Bassetlaw Action Centre. The minibus has the facilities to enable wheelchair users to board and alight using a passenger lift and specialist equipment to secure both the user and their wheelchair. All our drivers must hold D1 on their driving licence and will undergo an enhanced DBS check and MiDAS training.

DOES THE COUNCIL PROVIDE FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR COMMUNITY GROUPS?

Councillor Community Grants Scheme

Each District Councillor is allocated a small budget and has the discretion to award grants to community activities that will benefit the community within their respective electoral ward areas. Councillors will consider grant applications for sports; culture and heritage; environment and sustainability; social welfare; and community activities.

Unsuccessful applicants will be unable to reapply to the Councillor Community Grants scheme in the same year. Applications will only be accepted once the activity has been discussed with the ward member of Bassetlaw District Council.

Funding for the following, are unlikely to be considered:

- Activities which cover an area that is the primary responsibility of another funding agency
- Additional funding from Bassetlaw District Council
- Activities that do not support Bassetlaw residents
- Activities that promote religious belief or political activities
- Civic events
- Expenses that have already been incurred or retrospective funding
